### PRESS RELEASE

**Three (3) LPG tanks of 9.900 liters capacity detected in a warehouse.  
Operation coordinated by the OCC.**

The OCC received a complaint from the Customs Audit Services (ELYT) of Attica - Directorate General of Customs and Excise, stating that illegal bottling and supply of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), is being conducted in a warehouse located in the broader region of Lamia.

The Police Directorate of Fthiotida was informed requesting its assistance. At midday on 25-10-18, investigation was carried out by the police officers, leading to the detection and seizure of the following items:

- **Three (3) LPG tanks with a total capacity of 9.900 liters**
- **One hundred and six (106) LPG cylinder bottles**
- **Two thousand and four (2004) plastic safety plugs**
- **Various tools and materials required for the operation of the illicit LPG bottling plant**

The perpetrators were not traced, thus they were not found in flagrante delicto.

At the spot, officers of the Directorate for the Development of the Regional Unity of Fthiotida, were summoned in order to carry out an autopsy and impose the pertinent administrative sanctions. Officers of Customs Offices of Stylida, were also called to quantify the content of the tanks. Furthermore, samples from the tanks' content will be taken and checked by the Chemical Services of Livadia.

Upon completion of the investigation, a Police Report will be submitted to the competent Prosecutor's Office on the prosecution of those responsible and a conclusive petition will be composed to allocate and charge the corresponding administrative fines.
